

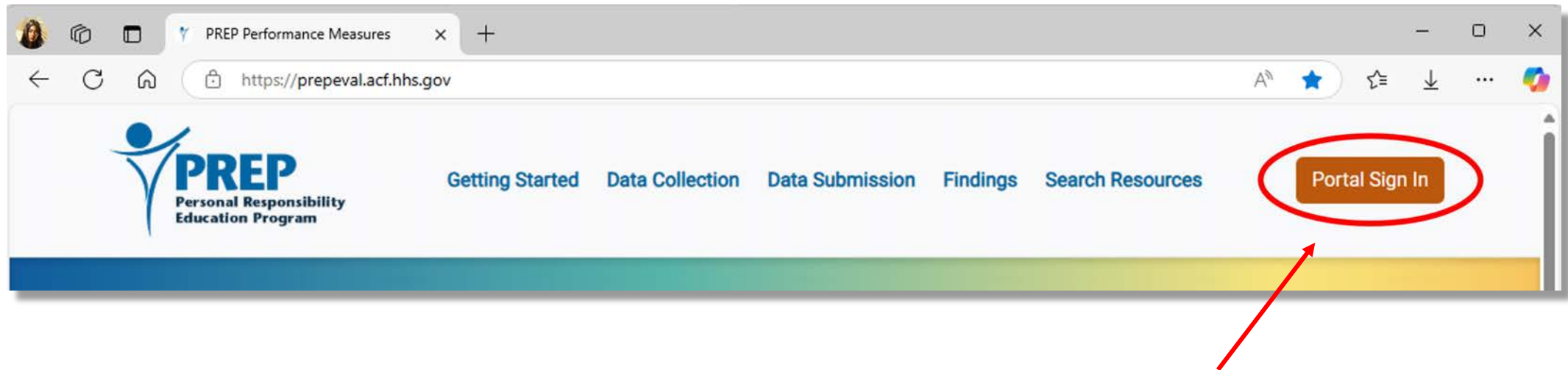

About the PREP Performance Measures

The federally-funded Personal Responsibility Education Program (PREP) supports efforts to educate youth on both abstinence and contraception for the prevention of pregnancy and sexually transmitted infections through evidence-based and evidence-informed programs, elements of effective programs, and innovative strategies. Programs also educate youth on adulthood preparation subjects. To understand whether grant objectives are being met and to contribute to lessons learned, ACF collects data on performance measures from all PREP grantees.

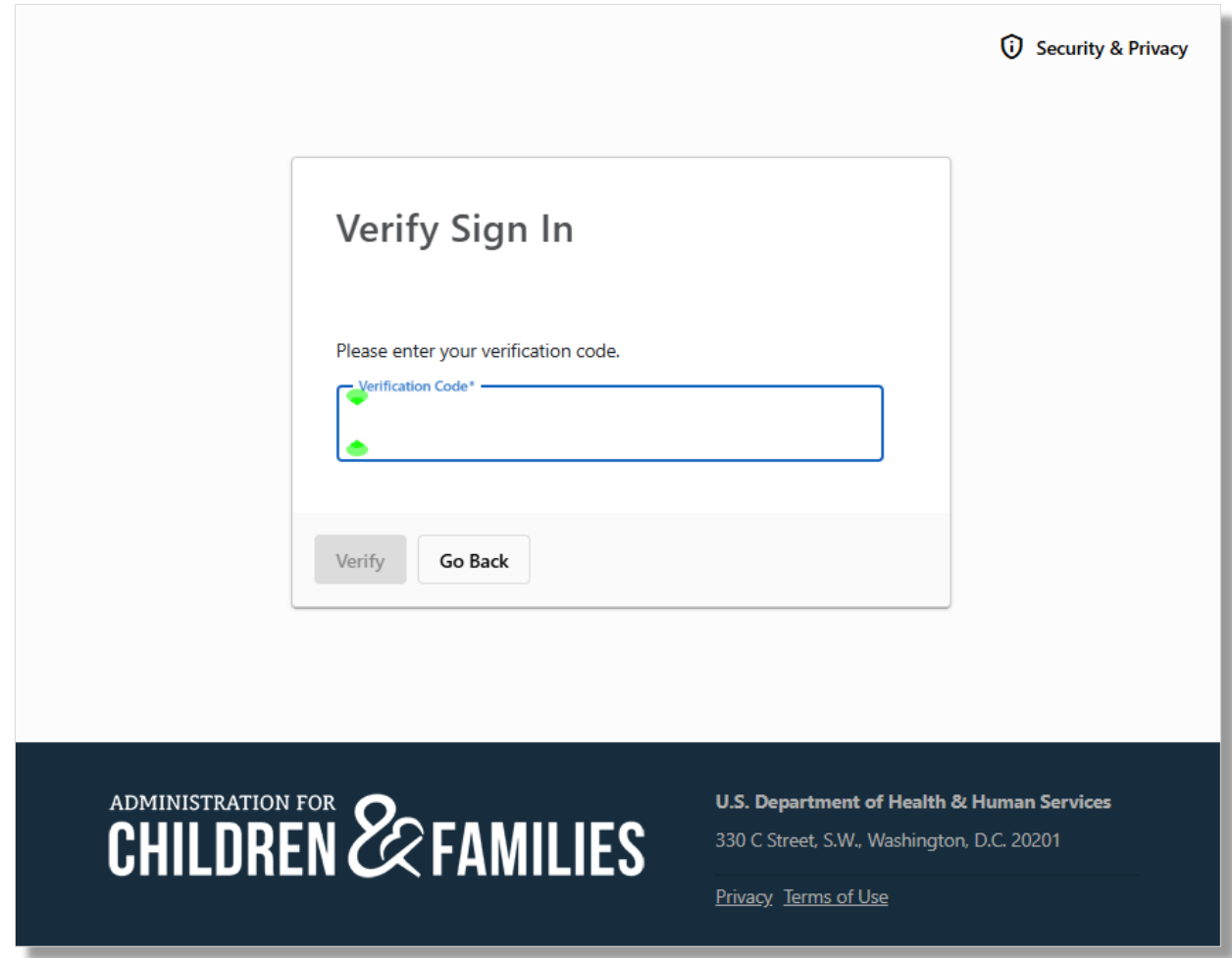

- Enter your username, which is the email address that you signed up with (you get the PREP emails at this address)
- Enter your password
- Click on Sign In

Verify your sign in

- The verification code will appear inside the authenticator app on your phone.
- It is **not** sent to you in an email or a text message.
- You must **open the authenticator app on your phone** and retrieve the code there.

Look for your authenticator app

- The three most commonly used authenticator apps are:
 - ✓ Google Authenticator
 - ✓ Cisco Duo, and
 - ✓ Microsoft Authenticator
- Their app icons (what you'll see on your phone) look like this



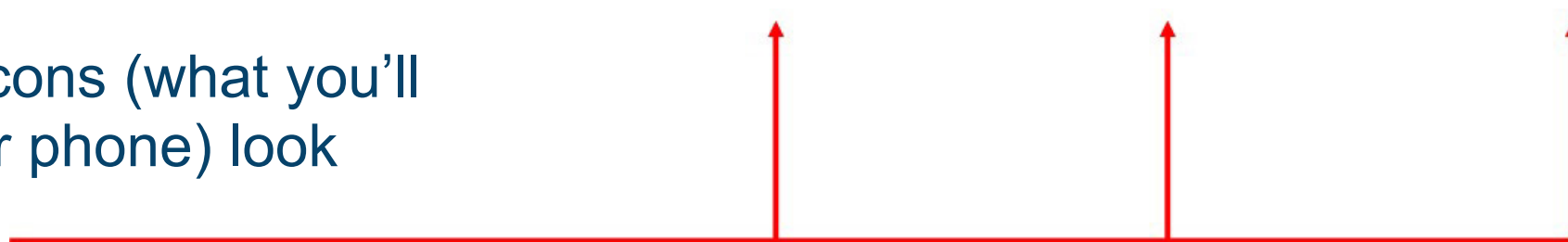

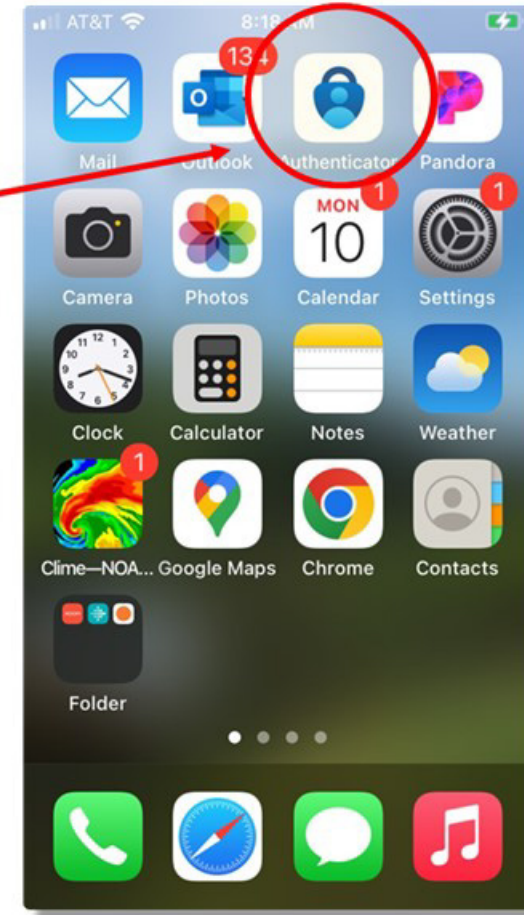

Open the authenticator app

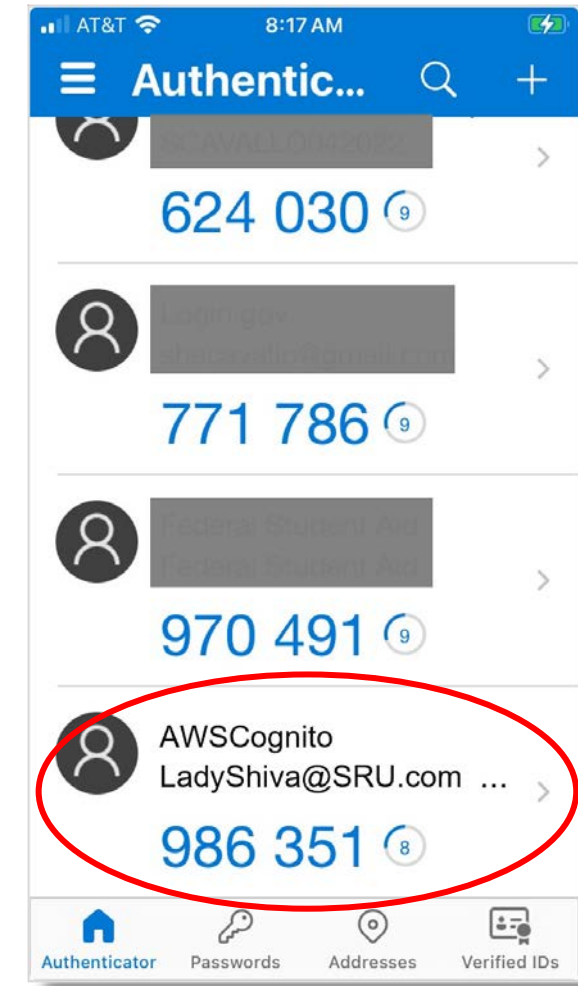
- Locate the authenticator app **on your phone** and open it.

(In this screen capture example, the app is Microsoft Authenticator. Yours may be something else.)



Open the authenticator app

- If you use your authenticator app for multiple accounts, you'll see a list of verification codes (like the example here).
- Grab the code for the PREP portal. It may be named something else in your app, or it may appear like it does here (AWSCognito).



Tips for using your code

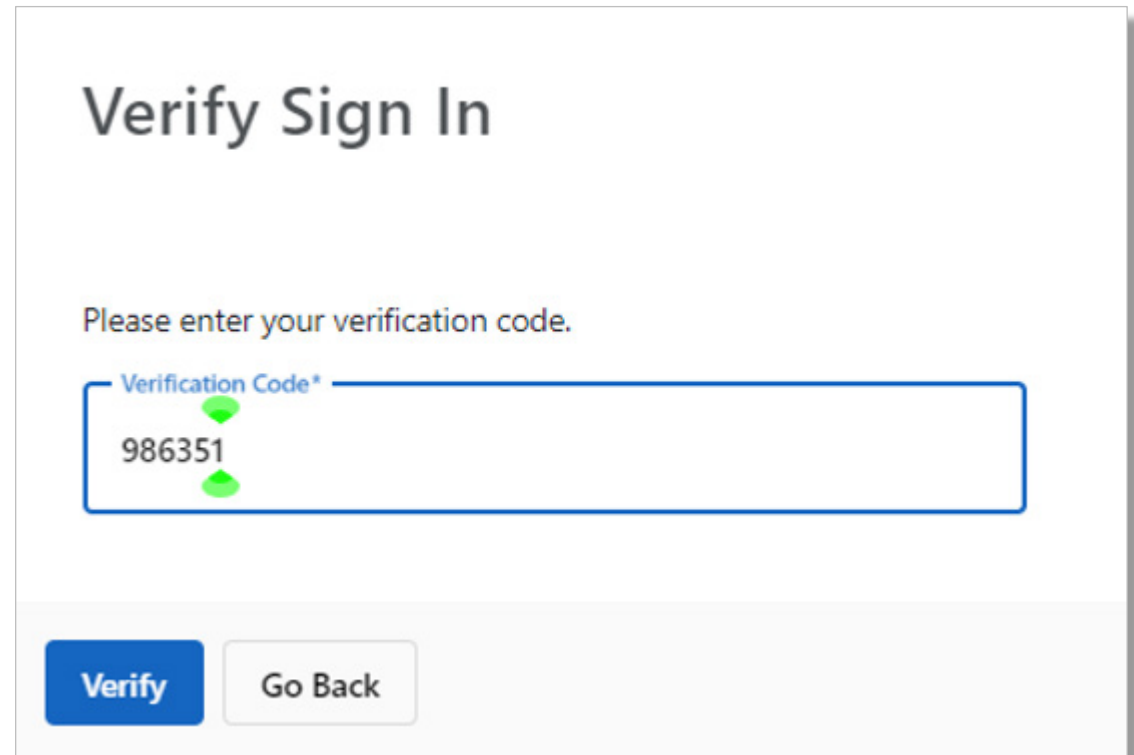
- Enter the code into the PREP portal without any spaces, just the numbers (i.e. 986351).



- The code is constantly changing and times out every 30 seconds.

Enter your verification code

- Enter your verification code into the box in the PREP portal
- Click “Verify”
- You’re in!
